Sustaining Ministry Excellence (\$400/week)

Our theme captures the spirit of the St. John's congregation. When others are in need, we respond. When hands are needed, people step up. When a community organization asks to use our space, we say yes. Your increased generosity helps to sustain all this work we do together.

More than half of our budget goes to compensation for our staff team, a critical part of what we do together. Your new gifts will enable continued support of our staff with appropriate salaries. It covers increased costs of paying utilities, supplies, service contracts, maintenance – all the things that keep church ministries going. A portion of our new gifts also replace gifts formerly given by faithful members who in the previous year have died or moved away from Beaufort.

Supporting staff and paying church support costs are foundational for deepening ministry in the congregation and expanding outreach in the community. In this appeal, we are invited to reflect on how we each as an important part of this congregation respond together to God's love and faithfulness to us!
